Patient History:


Mrs RJ had a history of diverticular disease and benign polyps

Hartmann's resection with end colostomy in 2017

Requires assistance from carers due to CVA (stroke) in 2011

She cannot talk and has difficulty with understanding her situation

 Discharged from hospital using a 2-piece closed pouch



Problems:

Developed periods of peristomal skin excoriation 9 months after surgery which has resulted in leakages

Nurse review:

- Peristomal skin excoriated
