

# for protecting peristomal skin with a flush double-barrelled stoma

### **Background**

- 64 year old lady.
- June 22 surgery for malignant mass in transverse colon.
- Extended right hemi-colectomy, partial resection of the greater gastric curvature and formation of double-barrelled stoma.

## **Problems Experienced**

- Stoma is flush to the skin level and close to the incisional wound and umbilical area.
- Irritant dermatitis experienced from initial pouching system.

#### **Nurse Advice**

July 22 - Suggestion to use eakin **dot**® 2-piece soft convex 80mm and eakin **freeseal**® to create a secure seal around the stoma.
