### Patient History:

- 74 year old lady
- Emergency Hartmann's Procedure for sigmoid perforation
- Poorly positioned, very retracted colostomy
- Complete mucocutaneous separation
- Discharged on a deep convex appliance



13th May

### Problems/ Nurse review:

- Developed peristomal ulcers attributed to pressure from appliance
- Changed to 2-piece flat drainable pouch with a seal
- Experienced poor wear time, leakages, painful excoriated, denuded skin
